The city of Bexley has leased the Caretaker's cottage at the Jeffrey Mansion Park to the Bexley Historical Society for their new home, office and museum. This dream has been 33 years in the making!

Our homes and parks in Bexley have been the site of much history. The Adena Indians lived along Alum Creek over 200 years ago. Artifacts have been discovered that show their way of life. The National Road was completed through Bexley by 1833 and Camp Bushnell was established during the Spanish American War in 1898 with its parade grounds at Drexel Circle.
